- **CEWS Program Extension** - On July 13th, 2020, Prime Minister Trudeau announced an extension of the CEWS program to December 2020. This is the second program extension. The wage-subsidy program covers 75 per cent of wages, up to a weekly maximum of \$847, for eligible companies and non-profits. Applications for claim period 4 (June 7 to July 4) are open as of July 8, 2020. More information is available by [clicking here](#).
- **Small and Medium Enterprise Relaunch Grant** – A reminder that the Government of Alberta has launched a new program to help fund small- and medium-sized businesses in the province as they relaunch following COVID-19 shutdowns. Applications are now open to all areas to apply for up to \$5,000 to offset costs due to the pandemic. The costs include extra cleaning supplies, physical barriers, personal protective equipment, as well as rent, wages, and inventory. The program will remain open for businesses to apply until Aug. 31, or for four weeks after Stage 3 of the provincial relaunch is implemented — whichever is later. - **Curling Alberta COVID Recovery Working Group Update & Webinar Link** - This group, formed by 22 club managers and presidents as well as Curling Alberta staff and Board members, has been meeting weekly to assist in our efforts to get back on the ice as safely as possible this season. Three subgroups have been created to organize webinar opportunities, create a "COVID Recovery Toolkit" for clubs, and to assist in the development of Curling Alberta's Return to Play Guidelines.
