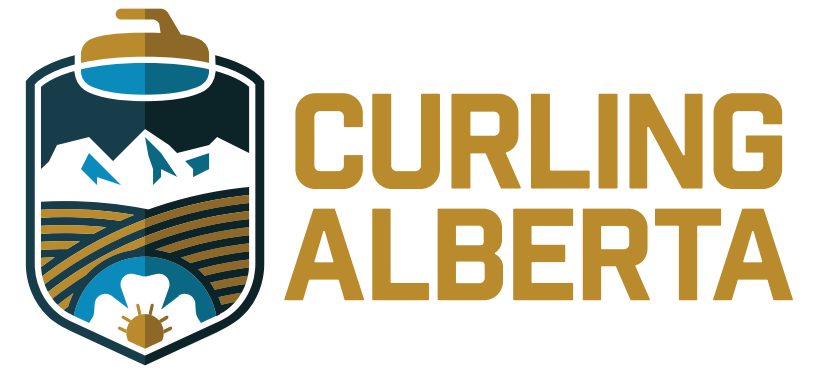
ACCESS TO COMPETITIONS & CHAMPIONSHIPS
