

1. The Raffle is open to all persons within in the Province of Alberta when purchasing tickets online. Ticket purchasers must be 18 years of age or older. Owners and Employees of the Service Provider (Raffle Box), and Curling Alberta, including its Board of Directors staff, and members of their immediate family (defined as mother, father, brother, sister, son, daughter, husband or wife, who reside in the same household) are NOT eligible to participate in the 50/50 Raffle. Each ticket sold shall be eligible to participate in each draw conducted under the authority of the AGLC Raffle License.
2. Ticket Purchasers may not transfer their tickets to anyone else before claiming the prize.
3. No Refunds. All ticket sales are final. There will be no refunds issued to anyone for any reason. All tickets purchased and for which the raffle numbers on those respective tickets are entered into the draw cannot be refunded, including if a ticket purchaser made an error in selecting the number of tickets they desired to purchase.
4. Tickets will be available online and sold at a rate of:
  - 1 for \$10 – 100,000 available
  - 5 for \$20 – 800,000 available
  - 20 for \$50 – 2,000,000 available
  - 100 for \$100 – 10,000,000 availableTotal of 12,900,000 tickets available for sale.
5. Tickets will be available for purchase starting at 9:00 am, Saturday, November 27th, 2021 MST and will close Sunday, March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 10:00 pm MST. The draw will take place on Sunday, March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 10:15 pm MST at the Enmax Centre (2510 Scenic Dr S, Lethbridge, AB, T1K 1N2).
6. The person(s) drawing the winning number must not hold a ticket for that draw.
7. The winner will receive cash prize of 50% of ticket sales. The minimum guaranteed cash prize will be \$50,000 up to a maximum of \$9,600,000.
8. The winner will be determined by a random draw utilizing a certified AGLC ERS provider's (Rafflebox's) random number generator. A physical ticket will not be mailed out for this draw. An email confirmation with purchasers' ticket numbers will be provided after purchase.
9. The winner will be notified by phone and email. The winner has three months to claim their prize.
10. Draw results will be announced on Curling Alberta social media channels and website, as well as email to our ticket-buyers.
