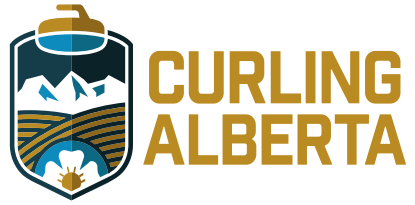

We have received generous and wholehearted support from all levels of government, local organizations, businesses, and Sponsors and we are indebted to them all for making this Championship possible.



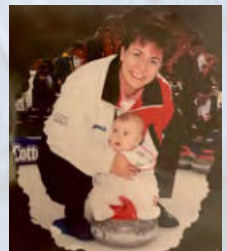
From Biggar, Saskatchewan, Sandra was a curling legend, a three-time Canadian and World Curling Champion and Olympic gold medalist. She was also a loving mother to two baby girls – Sara and Jenna. Sandra's greatest joy was her family.

Although cancer tragically took Sandra's life in 2000 when she was just 36 years old, her skill, determination and resilience on the ice ensure that her name will live on in the curling record books forever.

Sandra was honoured posthumously with an induction into both the World Curling Federation Hall of Fame and the Canadian Sports Hall of Fame.

The Sandra Schmirler Foundation, is committed to preserving an important legacy, the legacy of an Olympic Champion, a mother and a friend. That is why they came together to build the Sandra Schmirler Foundation – to ensure that babies born too soon, too small or too sick have the chance to grow up to be a champion like Sandra. # HISTORY OF THE



# GRANDE PRAIRIE CURLING CENTRE

The Grande Prairie Curling Club existing building opened in the fall of 1977. The previous structure was on the same location as the present building. Some of the key people on the building committee were Lee Merlo, Marcel Joberty, Perky McCullough, and Jack Berg.

The first major event hosted by our club was the 1978 Alberta Men's Provincials won by Ed Lukowich curling out of Medicine Hat Curling Club. Ed and his team would go on to win the Canadian Championships.

Since then, Grande Prairie has hosted numerous provincial Championships, Men's, Ladies, Juniors, Seniors and Masters. We have also hosted National Championships; 1992 Canadian Mixed, 1995 Canada Winter Games and 2016 Scott Tournament of Hearts. We also had the privilege of hosting the 2006 Ford World Ladies Championship.

Our club has always had a strong contingent of volunteers for hosting events with considerable support from other Peace Country curling clubs.

We are confident the 2022 Best of Alberta Men's and Ladies Provincial Championships will be another successful event.
