The Curling Coordinator will be responsible for the curling promotional activities and learning to curl activities of the junior program.

Qualifications

- Knowledge of curling and curling culture
- Good communication and organizational skills
- Experience working with youth and knowledgeable about the sport of curling
- Energetic, enthusiastic and interested in developing young curlers and promoting the sport of curling
- Must be able to coordinate and work well with volunteers
- Responsible, reliable, and competent
- Ability to work independently and achieve operational requirements
- Must have excellent public relations skills Will be working with/in the general public, volunteers, etc.
- Strong e-mail and inter-personal communication skills
- Strong organizational and time management skills
- Flexibility in volunteer hours, availability on some select bonspiel weekends October through March

Duties and Responsibilities

- Attend Curling Club Board meetings when required once a month during the curling season
- Organizing and obtaining enough qualified instructors / coaches
- Maintain a list of active instructors / coaches and their qualifications
- Organization, coordination, and administration of the leagues activities
- Keep a current list of all coaching courses being offered in Central Alberta and ensure they are posted with Bonspiels listings.
- Assist the Curling Club in the operation of Junior & High School League.
- Work with the Curling Club Members to create new ideas for Program as well as come up with new ideas for attracting and keeping youth curlers in our club.
- Helping to organize local Bonspiel events Ensuring volunteers are obtained to help run the Bonspiel
- Organize and coordinate volunteer positions where applicable
- Plan and coordinate the Year-End wrap up fun spiel / party
- Assist the Bonspiel Committee with the coordination of a multi-day Bonspiel
- General trouble-shooting and problem-solving
- Other activities working with the youth curling program as required
