WHAT?

Curling Alberta is recruiting three individuals to join the Youth Advisory Panel. This initiative connects the voices of young people from across Alberta with the organization's work and catalyzes support for its activities.

Members of the panel can expect to meet virtually at least three times during the curling season and will also participate in Curling Alberta's Annual General Meeting. Outside of scheduled meetings, group shall be self-directed to meet and progress the efforts of the panel as they see fit.

WHY?

Curling Alberta is an inclusive and collaborative organization. We are building a culture where difference is valued and where multiple approaches and points of view are celebrated. We are always growing our network of people, programs, and tools all designed to help spread the power of sport within and among our communities. Through this panel, we intend to empower and value the contributions of our youth and invest in the future leaders of our sport.

WHO?

We are looking for about 3 curlers eligible for U25 and younger who are:

- Passionate about curling
- Interested in multiple aspects of the sport (e.g.- growing participation at the grassroots level, performance stream athlete development, coaching, officiating, etc.)
- Creative thinkers
- Comfortable collaborating with others and working on a team
- Interested in developing their own leadership skills

Because Curling Alberta believes that diversity drives innovation, we hope to attract youth to this opportunity who reflect the diversity of our population.

HOW TO GET INVOLVED?
