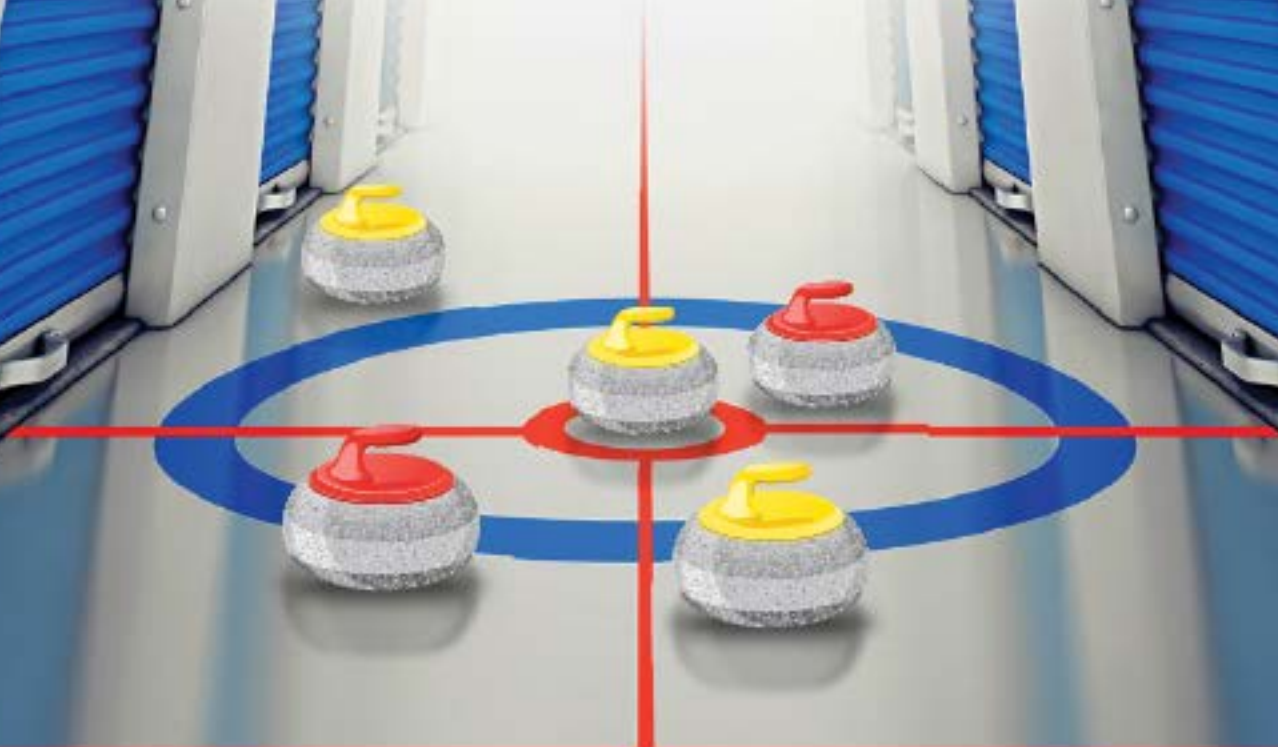
As a first-time host of the Curling Alberta Wheelchair Championships, we welcome all the teams, coaches, and officials. We hope that you enjoy your stay in the area.
