Subject: Notice of Proposed Bylaw Changes and Invitation to Review

Dear Member Clubs,

As part of our ongoing commitment to strong, effective governance, Curling Alberta has completed a comprehensive review and update of our bylaws in partnership with Sport Law. These updates are designed to modernize our governance framework and align with best practices for provincial sport organizations.

Key Change to Note:

One of the most significant proposed amendments is the removal of the geographic zone requirement for Directors. While Curling Alberta will no longer require Directors to reside in specific zones, we remain firmly committed to ensuring representation from across Alberta. We recognize the value of regional perspectives and will continue to encourage engagement from all areas within our boundaries.

This change supports our transition to a skills-based governance model, enabling us to better recruit Directors with the experience, qualifications, and strategic vision necessary to lead the organization into the future.

We believe these changes will help position Curling Alberta for long-term success by strengthening our leadership and broadening our reach.

We invite all member clubs to review the proposed bylaw updates in detail and to share any questions or feedback in advance of the Special General Meeting on September 19, 2025.
