

How to fill out the Membership Report:

Record all curlers at your club on this list who **participate FOUR OR MORE times in the season** with the exception of school groups and learn to curl participants. The following information is required:

- a. First Name
- b. Last Name
- c. Year of Birth
- d. Gender
- e. Email
- f. Community
- g. Postal Code
- g. Primary Role (see below for definitions)
- h. Secondary Role (Able-bodied, Stick Curler, Wheelchair Curler, Blind Curler, Deaf Curler)

Please record the total number of casual curlers at the top of the spreadsheet. Casual curlers include school groups, learn to curl participants and all other curlers who participate 3 times or less in a season.

Please note that there are drop down menus in the following categories: Primary Role, Secondary Role.

****ICF = Individual Curler Fee**

ROLES	DEFINITIONS	ICF (\$22)
Club league curler	A curler who has paid league dues to your curling club and plays 4 or more games in a season. These curlers are usually members of the curling club.	\$22/curler
Rental league curler	A curler who participates in an organized league that rents your facility in order to play 4 or more times in a season.	\$22/curler
Introductory Curler	A curler that is "sampling" the sport in a developmental or introductory program such as a one off "try-it", learn to curl, or school program, regardless of the number of sessions.	no fee
Casual Curler	A curler who plays <u>less than four times</u> in a season (ie spares and drop ins)	no fee

***possibility of \$1 personal accident insurance (drop-in / casual curlers)*

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**** The Individual Curler Fee (\$22) will not apply to introductory and casual curlers.**

**** If you have drop-in, introductory or casual curlers who will be covered by the personal accident insurance policy at a cost of \$1 per curler then you must keep a record of their names (see 3rd tab on this spreadsheet for a form you can use).**

**** If you do not have the ability to collect all mandatory information for introductory and casual curlers, you may submit just the total number of participants who meet this definition at the top of the membership participant report worksheet.**
