THE CURLING HORSE RACE

Event Overview

Get ready for an exciting, fast-paced curling challenge – The Horse Race! Competitors advance sheet by sheet, with each throw raising the stakes and tightening the target. Only the most accurate shooters will make it to the final sheet and compete for the cash prizes.

How It Works

All participants start on their assigned Sheet. Each curler throws one rock per round. To advance to the next sheet, your rock must finish inside of or touching the required ring. Miss the ring, and you're eliminated.

Sheet Target to Hit

Round 1	12-foot
Round 2	8-foot
Round 3	4-foot
Round 4	Button

Rules

If no one qualifies for any round everyone throws again. If only two people qualify for the next round they will be the only curlers to advance and the prize money will be split two ways, if only one advances then they will win first place and the remaining curlers from the previous round will throw one more rock to determine 2nd and 3rd.

In round 4 the closest to the button will be awarded prizes based on distance.

🥈 2nd Place: \$100

🥉 3rd Place: \$50

Additional Notes

In the event of a tie measurement, a coin toss determines who advances. Officials' decisions are final.

Curling Terms


Down:

1. The rotation applied to the handle of a stone that causes it to rotate in a clockwise direction and curl for a left-handed curler
3. A stone that just touches the outer edge of the circles
5. line across the ice behind the house
7. The foot-holds at each end of the ice from which the stone is delivered
8. Slippery material placed on the sole of the shoe

Across:

2. The amount a rock bends while travelling down the sheet of ice
4. The amount of force given to the stone during the delivery
5. A curling competition or tournament
6. At any time during an end, the stone closest to the button
9. The movement of a curling stone after it has struck a stationary stone in play
10. The rotation applied to the handle of a stone that causes it to turn and curl in a counter-clockwise direction for a left-handed curler.
11. A rock delivered with a greater force than necessary
