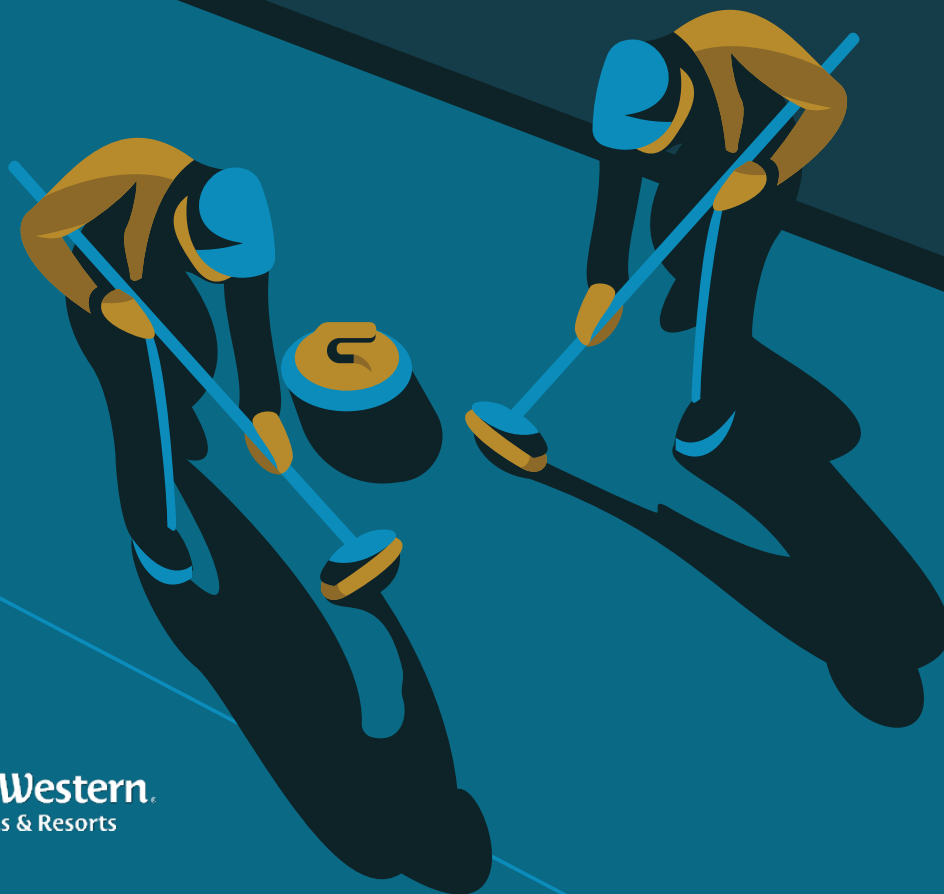

Welcome to the Alberta Best Western Mixed Doubles Championship, being held from February 5 – 8, 2026.

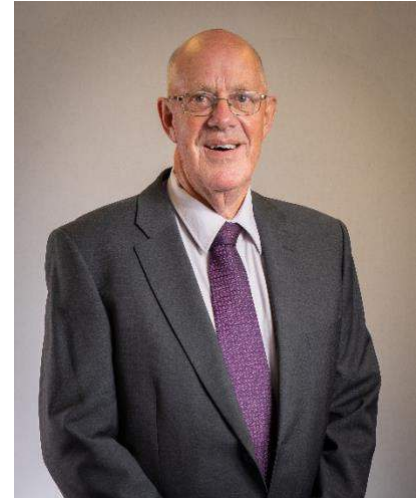

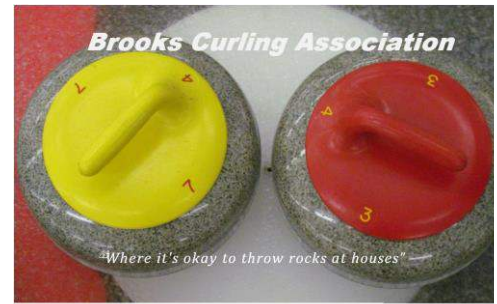
