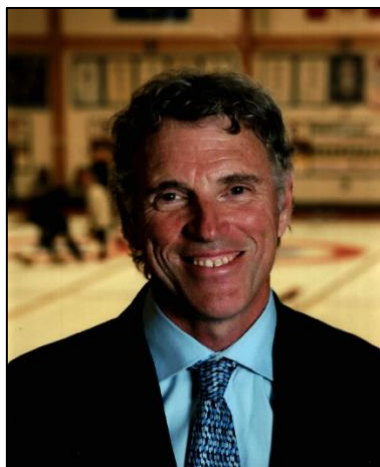

EQUIPMENT STORAGE – Players are welcome to utilize our locker rooms and the walkways around the ice surface for storage of their equipment. Please do **NOT** store equipment in the front lobby or upstairs lounge. Using the locker room is at your own risk and the North Hill Curling Club will not be held responsible for personal items.

SPECTATOR VIEWING – The upstairs lounge, on the second floor, will be open for spectators for the entire event. In addition, spectators are welcome to enjoy the downstairs viewing area **AFTER** the first rock is thrown and games have begun.

During the event, the downstairs viewing area is primarily reserved for curlers and umpires who are participating in or officiating games. Spectators and guests are welcome to use the space when it is available, but we kindly ask that priority always be given to curlers and umpires who require access. Please be considerate of those involved in the event and help keep the area accessible so everyone can enjoy the games comfortably.

EVENT PASSES – To help support the event and provide a great viewing experience for everyone, spectator passes will be available throughout the weekend.

Spectator Pass Pricing:

- \$5 per day
- \$20 full weekend pass

All spectators are asked to register upon arrival in the main lobby, where passes can be purchased before entering the viewing areas. Our volunteers and staff will be there to assist and help direct guests.
