### About the Role:

The Regional Ice Technician supports the work of Curling Alberta's Head Ice Technician by extending provincial ice services at the regional level. This role focuses on **club support, education delivery, and technical guidance**, helping ensure consistent standards, increased capacity, and broader reach across the province.

As a representative of Curling Alberta, the Regional Ice Technician acts as an **ambassador for the provincial and national curling system**, promoting leading practices and the value of **club affiliation**.

This role helps build **capacity, consistency, and confidence** across Alberta's ice technician workforce and may include participation in the **Curling Canada Ice Technician Facilitator & Evaluator Training** (Chilliwack, BC – August 2026).

### Key Responsibilities:

#### Regional Support & Club Service

- Provide consultation on ice preparation, maintenance, and troubleshooting
- Support consistent service delivery aligned with provincial and national standards
- Assist with technical support and event preparation as assigned
- Strengthen connections between clubs and the provincial/national system

#### Education & Workforce Development

- Deliver Ice Technician training (Assistant and/or Head), as assigned
- Promote participation in certification pathways
- Mentor and support developing ice technicians
- Provide feedback and reporting to the Head Ice Technician



### **System Alignment & Collaboration**

- Work closely with the Curling Alberta Head Ice Technician to ensure consistent delivery across regions
  - Act as a professional representative and ambassador for Curling Alberta
  - Contribute to continuous improvement of provincial programs and standards
